THIS JUST IN: Drive safely around our neighborhood and slow down around curves and corners and know that rolling stops at any stop sign is NOT ok. As you may have seen, the police have been visiting our roads more frequently recently due to numerous complaints. (And, there is a request that a person driving in the neighborhood daily, not gun their engine while driving through our streets! We know you love your truck...but there is a place for doing what you do....I am not sure where that is... but I know it is not on the streets of LaCabreah ~ and, we thank you in advance for your cooperation ~~ really!





DID YOU KNOW that if a burned out or malfunctioning street light has a number on the pole, you can call the city at 311 or go to their website at http://www.cityoffortwayne.org/citizen-services.html to request maintenance support; however, if the street light pole doesn't have a number on it, then you must call a maintenance board member at 385-6351 or 637-4948 to coordinate the repair service, as needed.

DID YOU KNOW that if your property borders a sidewalk or walking path within our community, it is expected that you will also maintain those by clearing the snow, too. (Everyone understands that if you do not own a snow blower, clearing the paths may take a few days after a heavy snow storm.)

DID YOU KNOW that it's not ok to shoot at geese from outside your walkout basement door way. Yes, back in September, a resident was noticed doing this by another resident and I was asked to remind this resident that what he was doing is illegal. Please refer to Geese Notes in this newsletter...and, if more of us pay to have eggs/geese controlled in the spring on our private properties the quantity of geese should reduce quickly from year to year.

VIOLATIONS





Violations may be things such as the need to remove unauthorized equipment such as a trampoline or shed, trash cans being stored in view of the street, long term parking of boats or trailers on streets or driveways, overdue association fees, grass/snow on sidewalks, or other events that are not in concert with our guidelines for the Community which are available at our website, http://www.lacabreah-hoa.com.

If you've been notified of a violation and were actually surprised it most likely was due to your failure to read the covenants or community guidelines that apply to your residence. Christmas Tree Recycling (No Pickup)

December 26 - January 15
Christmas trees will NOT be picked up by the City or County. You must bring bare tree to a drop off site. Ornaments, tinsel & plastic bags MUST be removed. Wreaths NOT accepted.

It is also illegal to dump Christmas trees in the woods by the trail – so just don't do that!
